Marquette Rail-Trail to allow year-round use. Sections of the Pere Marquette Rail-Trail receive a fresh coat of sealer each year and is in great condition. This is a flat, fast, exceptionally smooth trail, making it an easy ride for people of all abilities.

For a day trip, we recommend starting your journey at the downtown Midland Staging Area where you can check out "The Tridge," a unique three-span bridge crossing the confluence of the Tittabawassee and Chippewa rivers. As you head west, the trail passes by the Northwood University campus and the entrance to the Dow Historical Museum. You will also pass by several small parks, memorials, historic sites and natural areas along the trail as you travel through Sanford and Coleman on your way to Clare.
